BACKGROUND

The water depth ranges from 40-180m and should be available to perform the activity in the first half of 2025.

- The vessel must be available to perform the survey in the first half of 2025.
- The area to be covered is in a water depth ranging from 40-180 m.
- The area is located in the Timor Sea under the jurisdiction of the TIMOR LESTE Autoridade Nacional do Petroléo (ANP).
- The survey area location is approximately 344 km from Dili, the country capital of Timor-Leste and approximately 170 NM (315 km) from the port of Suai on the southern coast of Timor-Leste.
